Primary & Secondary Admissions 2021

The application process for <u>Secondary</u> School admissions is now open with the deadline on Saturday 31st October 2020. Please note that this date is in the October half term holiday.

The application process for <u>Primary</u> admissions for children born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017 opens on Monday 2 November 2020 with the closing date deadline of 15 January 2021.

We are reviewing how we can hold any **Open Morning** sessions for prospective parents whilst continuing to follow Covid 19 guidance. Further information and details of this will follow.

Attendance

We were delighted that we have had almost 100% attendance for each day this week in each class! It is usual at this time of year for many of our children to have colds and coughs. Whilst some schools are not accepting children in school with any symptoms of any illnesses, we feel that is important that children attend school regularly and wherever possible. If your child demonstrates any of the Covid 19 symptoms, please DO NOT SEND THEM TO SCHOOL. Please follow the steps in the accompanying guidance. We will continue to ask parents to keep their child at home for a period of 48 hours following a bought of diarrhoea or vomiting and this will commence from the last episode of illness. We will continue to contact you if your child becomes unwell at school and needs to be collected to go home. This will obviously include when we feel a child may be demonstrating Covid 19 symptoms. In this case, we will ask for you to arrange for your child to be tested as soon as possible and not return to school until we have confirmation of negative test or your child has self-isolated for 10 days from the onset of symptoms. If your child is generally unwell, please also consider if it is in their best interest to be at school. Please contact the school office if your child will be absent from school for any reason.

Curriculum Information for Parents and Carers

Curriculum information and class timetables are being sent home with this newsletter – these enable parents to see what we will be teaching this term and how the days will be structured. The timetable also allows you to see when the children will be having PE lessons. On PE days children should come to school in their PE kit.

If your child suffers from asthma and has an inhaler, we need to place them on our Asthma Register. Any child suffering from an allergy should also be recorded on our files. Any pupils with EpiPens will need to have an updated Health Care Plan. Please liaise with Mrs Hibon or Mrs Butler in the school office.

Pupil Premium Funding and Free School Meals

Since the introduction of Universal Infant Free School Meals for Key Stage 1 pupils, there has been a significant reduction in the number of families applying for Pupil Premium/Free School Meals funding. If you have a child who has moved into Year 3, school meals are now chargeable. As a school we also benefit financially from funding for Pupil Premium pupils so even if your child is in Key Stage 1 we would encourage you to apply. Not only will the school receive additional funds, it also saves you having to remember to apply when your child moves into Year 3. Schools across the country are reporting an increase in Free School Meal applications due to the effects of lockdown and subsequent job losses and reduced hours. We would also like to reassure parents that Free School Meals information is dealt with sensitively and on a need to know basis.
