## Uniform

We are proud of our school uniform at Hexton and what it represents as part of our community.

- All children should have a Hexton sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Boys should wear grey trousers, or in the summer, shorts.
- Girls should wear a grey skirt or pinafore of a suitable length for school or grey trousers. In the summer, girls may wear suitable dresses in the school colour, blue.
- Shirts, t-shirts, blouses and polo shirts should be white.
- Sensible black shoes or black trainers without logo should be worn in and around school.

All clothing should be clearly named.

## PF Kit

For PE children require:

- Plimsolls for children in Acorn class.
- Trainers for children in Oak class.
- Blue shorts and a Hexton white t-shirt for PE and games. House t-shirts are also available.
- A Hexton 'Hoody' and black track suit bottoms for outdoor PE.

All kit, including footwear, should be clearly named. Children may come to school in their PE uniform on their PE days.

## Jewellery and Personal Property
