

Headteacher's Message

This week the weather was better than anticipated and we have enjoyed some warm and sunny days playing and learning outside. This week was SATs week for our year six pupils. This involves pupils completing 6 statutory, standardised assessment tests in English and maths, under exam conditions. A huge congratulations to them for their hard work and progress this year, and getting through their SATs week with a smile on their faces. We are all so proud of them.

Over the next month, we also have KS1 SATs for year 2 pupils (these are not under exam conditions), the KS1 phonics screening (Years 1 and 2) and the year 4 multiplication check. These are all statutory. If you would like to discuss what these mean for your child, please make a meeting with your child's teacher.

This week we have had an exciting week for the creepy crawlies in school! The caterpillars have now formed their chrysalides in Acorn class and are beginning their metamorphosis. On Thursday, Oak welcomed some stick insects into class! They have been fascinated looking at them and learning about their life cycle.

Mrs Parratt joined us for assembly on Thursday this week and talked to the children about boasting. She told the story of the sun and the wind, and we reflected on how it might make others feel if we were to boast about how easy we find a particular skill.

100% Attendance


Congratulations to all the children who have achieved 100% attendance this week, coming to school every day, on time.
